Charleston, SC – The City of Charleston's Keep Charleston Beautiful and the Charleston Chapter of Surfrider Foundation are hosting a marsh cleanup event on Wednesday, March 27, 2013 from 4:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. to remove litter from the area under the Ravenel Bridge in downtown Charleston. This event is open to the public and anyone wishing to volunteer is welcome for any period of time. Volunteers will meet in the City of Charleston parking lot on Cooper Street near East Bay Street.

Cleanup efforts will focus on the marsh areas and volunteers should be prepared to get muddy. The volunteers' efforts will help keep the marsh and natural areas clean and safe for wildlife while helping to maintain the beauty of this wonderful area.

Cleanup supplies, including trash bags, gloves, and pickup sticks, will be provided. This is an event for ages 17 years and up.
