City of Charleston to Offer Summer of Service Events for Local Youth

Charleston, S.C.—Youth Volunteer Corps (YVC) of Charleston will host a series of Summer of Service leadership development opportunities, service projects and team building events for Berkeley, Charleston and Dorchester County youth. The events will span four weeks throughout June, July and August, with the first four-day series beginning on Monday, June 26.

The Summer of Service events – which include a combination of Leadership Days for rising 7th and 8th graders, and Event Days for 11- to 18-year-olds – are designed to provide tools for youth to be successful as they navigate middle and high school, and encourage them to become leaders in their communities.

All youth will earn volunteer hours for their participation.
