City of Charleston and Fetter Health Care offer Walk-up COVID-19 Vaccines Today

Charleston, S.C.--Today, Wednesday, April 21, 2021, City of Charleston and Fetter Health Care Network in partnership with Morris Brown AME Church will offer the Moderna vaccine from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Arthur W. Christopher Community Center located at 265 Fishburne Street, Charleston, S.C. 29403.

No appointment is necessary. All individuals over the age of 18 are eligible to receive the vaccine. A clinic for the second dose will be held May 17, 2021 at the same location.
