APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In an effort to assist our residents with disabilities, the Department of Traffic and Transportation will accept requests from residents with a disability to have an on-street disability parking space installed on the public right-of-way. To request a disability parking space you must meet the following criteria:

- The request is for a residence/business located on a public street within the City of Charleston
- Applicant has a current disability license plate or placard issued by the State of South Carolina
- Applicant does not have access to off-street parking
- Neighborhood supports application for parking adjustments

NOTE: Designated disability parking spaces may be used by anyone with a valid disability license plate or placard.
