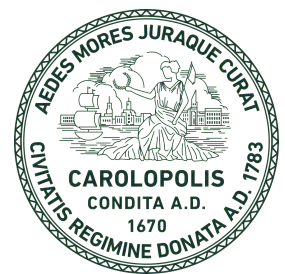
Orleans Woods Neighborhood Association
